TO THE PENDENTS (Cost to insure)

When dependents become part of the benefit plan, **individual cost for health insurance increases** to \$5,828, dental increases to \$646, and vision increases to \$236. Similarly, the cost to employers of insuring dependents increases significantly for health (\$11,955), dental (\$507), and vision (\$138).
